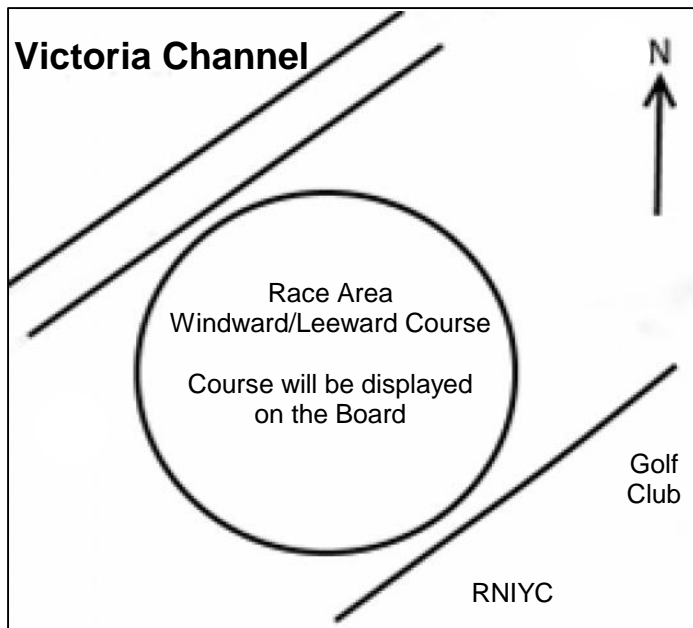
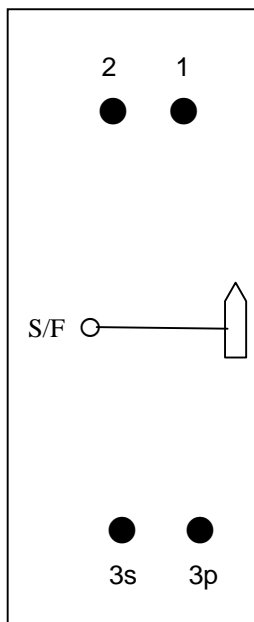

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

11. STANDARD SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The current BLYC Standard Sailing instructions (SSIs) are downloadable from the BLYC website and should be read in conjunction with these SIs. They all apply to this regatta, with the exception of **SSI No.10, WHICH SHALL NOT APPLY.**

12. CLASSES

Racing will be held for Race Nos 1 – 11 and, in addition, there will be a start for the BLQTC Class (Race No 0). Competitors in NHC Restricted and Unrestricted Cruiser classes, who wish to compete in the 'Round The Lough Race', should refer to separate Sailing Instructions available on the RNIYC website.

13. START TIMES

Classes will start according to the following schedule:

COMPETITORS SHOULD NOTE THAT

Start Times differ from those shown in the BLYC Standard Sailing Instruction 10

14. START LINE

The Starting Line shall be between the main mast of the Committee Boat (which will be displaying an orange flag while on station) and the Outer Limit Mark. An inner Limit Mark may be laid near the Committee Boat. All courses shall start to windward.

15. COURSES (See diagram)

Descriptions of the courses to be sailed will be posted in the Clubhouse on the Official Notice Board.

16. RACING MARKS

Marks will be large yellow spherical buoys.

17. FINISH LINE

The Finishing Line shall be between the mainmast of a Committee Boat, displaying a blue flag, and an Outer Limit buoy.

18. RETIREMENTS

Boats retiring are requested to advise the Race Committee as soon as possible by VHF Channel 'M' (37) or advising any official race patrol boat.

DEEP WATER CHANNEL

Competing boats are required to give way to any ship underway in the Victoria Channel. Failure to do so may result in disqualification from the event.

VISITOR'S MOORINGS

Please use moorings with yellow hand buoys.

SOCIAL

Refreshments will be available at RNIYC.

PRIZES

Prize distribution will take place as soon as possible after racing and may be on the basis of provisional results, if all protests have not been resolved.
