11. NOTICE OF RACE & STANDARD SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The current BLYC Notice of Race (NoR) and Standard Sailing instructions (SSIs) are downloadable from the BLYC website and should be read in conjunction with these SIs. They all apply to this regatta with the exception of **SSI No.10, WHICH SHALL NOT APPLY.** (Note that SSI 9 has been modified by SI 19.)

12. CLASSES

Racing will be held for BLYC Races No 3, 7-11. Competitors in NHC Restricted and Unrestricted Cruiser classes (BLYC Races 1, 2, 4, 5 & 6), who wish to compete in the 'Round The Lough Race', should refer to separate Sailing Instructions available on the RNIYC website.

13. START TIMES

Classes will start according to the following schedule:

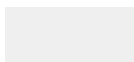
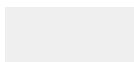
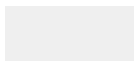

COMPETITORS SHOULD NOTE THAT

Start Times differ from those shown in the BLYC Standard Sailing Instruction 10

14. START LINE

The Starting Line shall be between the main mast of the Committee Boat (which will be displaying an orange flag while on station) and the Outer Limit Mark. An inner Limit Mark may be laid near the Committee Boat.



15. COURSES (See diagram)

Race No 3: Two rounds of the Long Course

Race No 7: One round of the Long Course and one round of the Short Course

Race No 8: Two rounds of the Short Course

Race No 9 - 11: Two rounds of the Long Course

If a **RED FLAG** is displayed - all rounding marks to be rounded to **PORT**

If a **GREEN FLAG** is displayed - all rounding marks to be rounded to **STARBOARD**

Long Course: Start Line, Marks 1, 2, 3, 4, Start/Finish Line

Short Course: Start Line, Marks 1, 3, 4, Start/Finish Line

An approximate compass bearing to the first mark shall be displayed on the committee boat prior to the start of the first class.

16. RACING MARKS

Marks 1 - 4 will be large yellow spherical buoys.

17. FINISH LINE

The Finishing Line shall be between the mainmast of a Committee Boat, displaying a blue flag, and an Outer Limit buoy.

18. RETIREMENTS

Boats retiring are requested to advise the Race Committee as soon as possible by VHF Channel 'M' (37) or advising any official race patrol boat.

19. TIME LIMIT

In amendment of SSI 9 the time limit shall be 16:00 and the extended time limit shall be 17:00.

DEEP WATER CHANNEL

Competing boats are required to give way to any ship underway in the Victoria Channel. Failure to do so may result in disqualification from the event.

VISITOR'S MOORINGS

Please use moorings with yellow hand buoys.

SOCIAL

Refreshments will be available at RNIYC.

(Subject to whatever Covid restrictions are in place at the time)

PRIZES

Prize distribution will take place as soon as possible after racing and may be on the basis of provisional results, if all protests have not been resolved.
