SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

11.1 STANDARD SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The current BLYC Standard Sailing instructions (SSIs) are downloadable from the BLYC website and should be read in conjunction with these SIs. They all apply to this regatta.

11.2 Sigma and CYCA boats will start with their appropriate NHC band as set out in SSI 10, within the BLYC Regatta Programme.

1.3 The Belfast Lough Quarter Ton Class has been designated as Class Q and shall have Code Flag Q as its Class Flag. Boats competing in race Q shall conspicuously display flag Q from or near their backstays. Failure to do so will result in the boat being scored DNC without a hearing (amends RRS 63.1).

11.4 The starting sequence shown in SI 10 of the BLYC Standard Regatta SIs is augmented by the addition of a scheduled start for Race 0 (using code flag Q), five minutes ahead of the start time shown for Race 1 (i.e. at 13:15).

11.5 In SI 5 of the BLYC Standard Regatta SIs, delete the reference to "Race 1" and insert "Race 0"

12. STARTS

12.1 Start Line

The start line will be between an ORANGE pole on the port shrouds of the committee boat and a GREEN spherical buoy. The committee boat will be stationed approximately 1 nautical mile to the north of Ballyholme Bay.

12.2 Direction of Start

All races will start to windward.

13 FINISH

The finish line will be between a Red Buoy (positioned off the RUYC Battery) and a white Pole with an X topmark in front of the battery. Boats having finished shall not re-cross the finishing line.

14 COURSES

14.1 All classes shall start to windward.

14.2 Marks

Course marks shall be YELLOW inflatable spherical buoys.

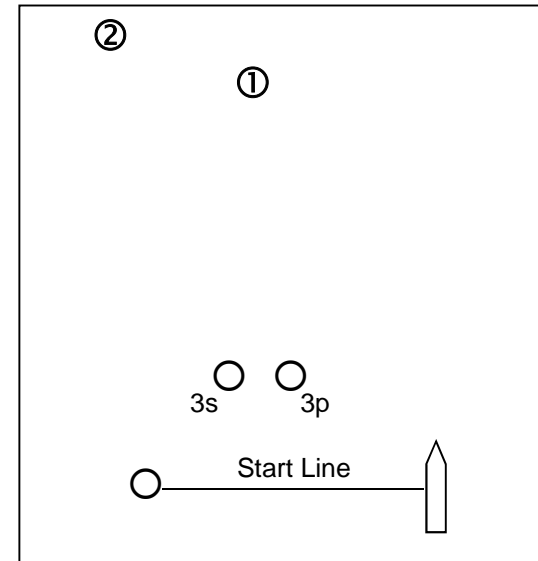
RUYC Mark 1 is a large red inflatable buoy, marked with the number "1", north of the Bangor Marina north breakwater.

14.3 After Starting, boats shall round the marks in the stated order, leaving them to port, with the exception of Mark 3s, which shall be left to starboard:-

Races 0, 5, 9 and 10 - 1, 2, 3p (or 3s), 1, 2, 3p (or 3s), 1, 2, 3p (or 3s), RUYC Mark 1, Finish Line

Races 1, 2, 3, 4 and 11 - 1, 2, 3p (or 3s), 1, 2, 3p (or 3s), 1, 2, 3p (or 3s), 1, 2, 3p (or 3s), RUYC Mark 1, Finish Line

Races 6, 7 and 8 - 1, 2, 3p (or 3s), 1, 2, 3p (or 3s), RUYC Mark 1, Finish Line
